**The visa invitation letter application process through Uppersia.com**

1. Go to the visa form page , fill out the form and email it to us including a photo of your passport and a passport size photo.
2. Wait for the Uppersia team confirmation.
3. Your application will be reviewed by the MFA.
4. We get the confirmation letter and will send it to you.
5. You refer to the selected consulate or at the airport on arrival and collect your visa.

**The Visa Invitation Letter (LOI) is only valid for the selected consulate or airport and remains effective for a period of 3 months.**
